December 28th, 2010: Eco-friendly, handicap accessible cottages

We have completed two nice cabins with bathrooms and two separate bedrooms. The cottages are environmentally friendly and will be adapted for disabled guests. The first guests who were staying in the cabins were quite enthusiastic.

November 20th, 2010: New building project in the autumn

We are building during the off season before Christmas! Our skilled craftsmen enlarge two cottages close to the forest. Both houses will have two separate bedrooms and a bathroom. The cabins are specially adapted for wheelchair users and visually impaired guests. We chose an environmentally friendly method of construction and insulated with up to 40 cm insulation, changed to tree-glass windows and used environmentally friendly building materials. To create a new seasonal site, we moved about 40 car trailers with sand and topsoil. The site is situated close to the woods and near the sauna.



August 20th, 2010: Summer

This summer we had a record number of guests from more than 15 nations in place. They came e.g. from Thailand, Russia, Australia and New Zealand. One couple came all the way from Moscow on their motorcycles! Our new beaver was a success - we saw plenty of beavers and bats in the great outdoors and enjoyed the total silence on the lake. In July, we had a quite unusual visit from a moose cow with her two calves who wandered around at the campsite - not shy at all.

An inspection by the association 'Keep Sweden Tidy' was a great pleasure for us: In his inspection report the inspector wrote that our environmental

work is exemplary for other campsites in Sweden - we are particularly delighted and will try to become even better in the future.

During this summer you can rent our luxury caravans modell KABE Ametist 2008. These caravans have 4 beds (2 double beds). The inner caravan size is 522x235 cm. The front bed has a size of 225x137/130 cm, the rear beds are about 196x120 cm tall. The caravans are equipped with kitchen utensils, radio, tv, wc and underfloor heating. NOTE: The caravans are animal free and non-smoking. They are suitable for allergy sensitive people.

Price per night: 580 SEK (about 60 EUR)
